

Sprint Evaluation

What is the progress of your project in this sprint? What goals are achieved? What problems are overcome? If you are updating your plans what are your justifications?

In this sprint, we planned to develop an Android application that shows Wi-Fi lists in the surrounding environment, research the topics related to our project such as data link layer, raw socket, OpenWrt, MAC addresses and NFC. Moreover, we planned to develop Android application that communicates two Android mobile devices. We completed both Android applications but we will improve them in the next sprint. The research part is always in progress but we completed the planned researches of the first sprint.

We did not have experience on Android application development. Moreover, we have not taken the Network course before. Therefore, becoming familiar with this concepts took lots of time of us. That is the problem we encountered. However, we overcame this problems by reading lots of papers.

We changed our sprint plan a little bit. While planning the sprint, we thought that we will create an application related with raw_socket (Sprint1- Task T4). However, after having more knowledge about the socket programming, we realized that it is a very basic part of planned Android application that discovers the devices which are on the same coverage area of a certain Wi-Fi router (Sprint1- Task T5). Therefore, we canceled T4 and replaced it with T5.
